SUPERVISOR REGISTER

Purpose

The purpose of this document is to articulate the policy and procedures around management of the WA Supervisor Register.

The Supervisor Register is provided as a resource to identify AASW member CPD Accredited social workers who provide a supervision service. Members can register their availability with the WA Branch by completing Form 1.

Responsibility

Management of the Supervisors Register is the responsibility of the WA Branch office. Listing on the Register should not be interpreted as a recommendation of any individual supervisor by the AASW WA as the AASW WA takes no responsibility for assessing the credentials of the supervisors listed on the Register. The AASW WA will not be involved in any arrangements between supervisors and supervisees.

AASW WA Branch office will be responsible for advising members on the Register of annual renewal through the detail supervisors have provided to the WA Branch office. If the supervisors contact details change it is their responsibility to contact the WA Branch to update.

Supervisors wanting to change details or remove themselves from the website should contact WA Branch office.

Person seeking supervision: Supervisees should obtain independent references regarding credentials and reputation of the potential supervisors' skills and training. The choice of supervisor will be the responsibility of the supervisee on the basis of information provided by the Supervisors and any other information obtained.

Eligibility to be included on the Register

Eligibility for inclusion on the WA Supervisor Register will be for individual financial and Accredited AASW members. Accreditation and financial status of members will be confirmed at time of registration, at annual renewal and intermittently during the year. Non financial members or those who are not accredited will be removed from the Register. Supervisors must meet the standards as detailed in the AASW Practice Standards on Supervision (see below for link).

Cost

An initial non refundable administration fee of \$30 (inc GST) will be charged to the applicant (the supervisor) for the first year, and non refundable \$20 (inc GST) for annual renewal. The primary intention of the Register is as a service to members and not as an advertising mechanism.

Accessibility

Consent by supervisors to have details placed on the website will be a required part of registration. Potential supervisors who do not consent to having their details on the website will not be able to register as a supervisor through the WA Branch office.

Details to be placed on the website will be minimal to ensure member security. Contact address will be limited to general location for supervision e.g, North Perth, as provided by the supervisor on their registration form. Fees and details of availability should be discussed by the supervisor with interested persons.

AASW (WA) reserves the right to develop uniform layout and presentation of supervisors' information.

When the Register becomes available on the website access will be in the public domain, under the WA Branch area, consistent with websites of other service professions. Until then the access will be via the WA monthly e-newsletter and through the office.
