Abstract Submission Process

Prepare abstract as per the guidelines described below and email to Rosanna Di Grazia at the AASW Victorian Branch via aaswvic@aasw.asn.au by **5th July 2018**

- Paper's Title in Title Case, Arial, bold 14pt font and centred;
- Full author list in Arial 12 pt. font (first initial and last name, degrees and professional titles no required), each authors institution should be footnoted, presenting author/s underlined;
- Primary person's contact details (phone number and email address) in Arial 12 pt. font;
- Text of 200 words outlining proposed presentation in Arial 12 pt. font; and
- Please indicate your preference re: oral presentation or poster presentation.

Selection Process

Abstracts will be rated anonymously against the following criteria:

- Relevance to the theme and objectives of the symposium
- Clarity of presentation
- Contribution of new knowledge or practice models to the field
