Aim:

To enable the achievement by all participants of a satisfactory level of competence for supervising social work staff in an effective, efficient and sensitive manner. The course focuses on staff rather than student supervision although there are many overlapping skills.

Process:

The course will focus on the development of supervisory skills, techniques and knowledge using a variety of methods, including presentations, small group discussion and experiential learning assisted by the use of video.

Assessment:

After completion of the course, participants will be asked to video a real supervision session in their workplace then submit it for assessment accompanied by a critical reflection. Feedback will be given in an individual coaching session. The assessment attracts additional CPD hours.

PAMELA COHEN MSW, MAASW (Acc). Pam was the Senior Staff Supervisor at St Vincent's Hospital in Sydney and now has a private practice at St Vincent's Clinic.
